

# Firearms Compliance & Shipping Policy

West Coast Components Pty Ltd (“we”, “us”, “our”) operates in strict compliance with all applicable **Australian federal, state, and territory firearms laws**.

This policy outlines our legal obligations and customer responsibilities relating to firearms, firearm parts, controlled items, and shipping.

## Licensing & Legal Compliance

- Customers are responsible for ensuring they hold **all required licences, permits, and approvals** prior to purchasing any regulated item.
- We reserve the right to **request proof of licensing** before processing or shipping any order.
- Orders may be **cancelled or refused** if required documentation is not provided or does not meet legal requirements.
- No refunds will be issued for orders cancelled due to licensing or legal non-compliance by the customer.

## Compliance Summary

West Coast Components Pty Ltd operates as a **licensed Australian manufacturing and firearms-related business**, conducting activities in accordance with all applicable **Commonwealth, state, and territory firearms legislation**.

Key compliance principles include:

- All firearms, controlled items, and regulated components are sold or transferred **only in accordance with Australian law**
- Customers are responsible for holding valid **licences, permits, and approvals** prior to purchase
- Licensing verification may be required before an order is processed or shipped
- Firearms and controlled items are **not sold or shipped to unlicensed individuals**

- Firearms and controlled items will only be transferred in accordance with **state and federal firearms legislation**, including dealer-to-dealer or dealer-to-licensed-individual transfers where permitted.
- We do not ship firearms directly to unlicensed individuals.

### **Firearm Parts & Components**

- Certain firearm parts and components may be regulated depending on jurisdiction.
- Customers are responsible for confirming the legality of purchasing and possessing firearm parts in their state or territory.
- We reserve the right to refuse sale or shipment of parts if legal compliance cannot be confirmed.

### **Gunsmithing & Services**

- All gunsmithing services, machining work, repairs, and custom builds are **final sale**.
- Once work has commenced, orders cannot be cancelled or refunded.
- Customers acknowledge that firearms and components provided for service are submitted **at their own risk**, except where otherwise required under law.

### **Shipping & Delivery**

- Shipping methods are selected at our discretion to ensure legal compliance and security.
- Firearms and controlled items may only be shipped to:
  - Licensed firearms dealers, or
  - Licensed individuals where legally permitted
- Shipping timelines are estimates only and may be affected by:
  - Licensing verification

- Regulatory approvals
- Carrier restrictions
- Government processing delays

West Coast Components Pty Ltd is not liable for delays caused by regulatory or carrier requirements.

### **International Orders**

- International sales are subject to **export controls, import regulations, and licensing requirements**.
- Customers are solely responsible for ensuring compliance with their local laws.
- We do not guarantee approval of international shipments.
- Orders refused, seized, or delayed due to regulatory issues are **not eligible for refund**, except where required under Australian Consumer Law.

### **Refused or Returned Shipments**

- Orders returned due to incorrect licensing information, refusal of delivery, or failure to comply with legal requirements may incur:
  - Restocking fees
  - Shipping and handling charges
- Refunds, where applicable, will be processed in accordance with our **Returns & Refunds Policy**.

### **Right to Refuse Service**

We reserve the right to refuse any sale, service, or shipment at our discretion where:

- Legal compliance cannot be verified
- Safety concerns arise
